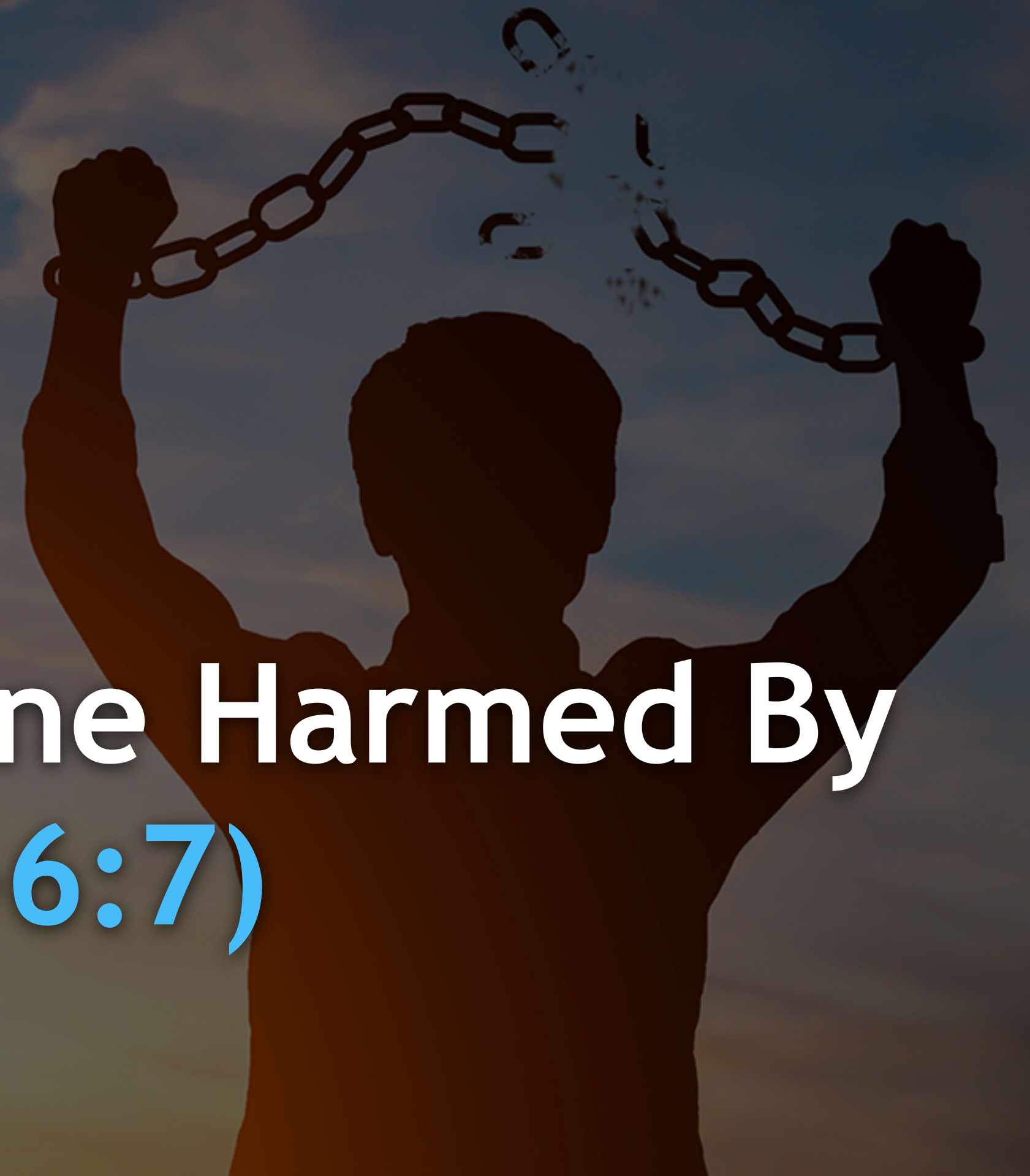

Matthew 5

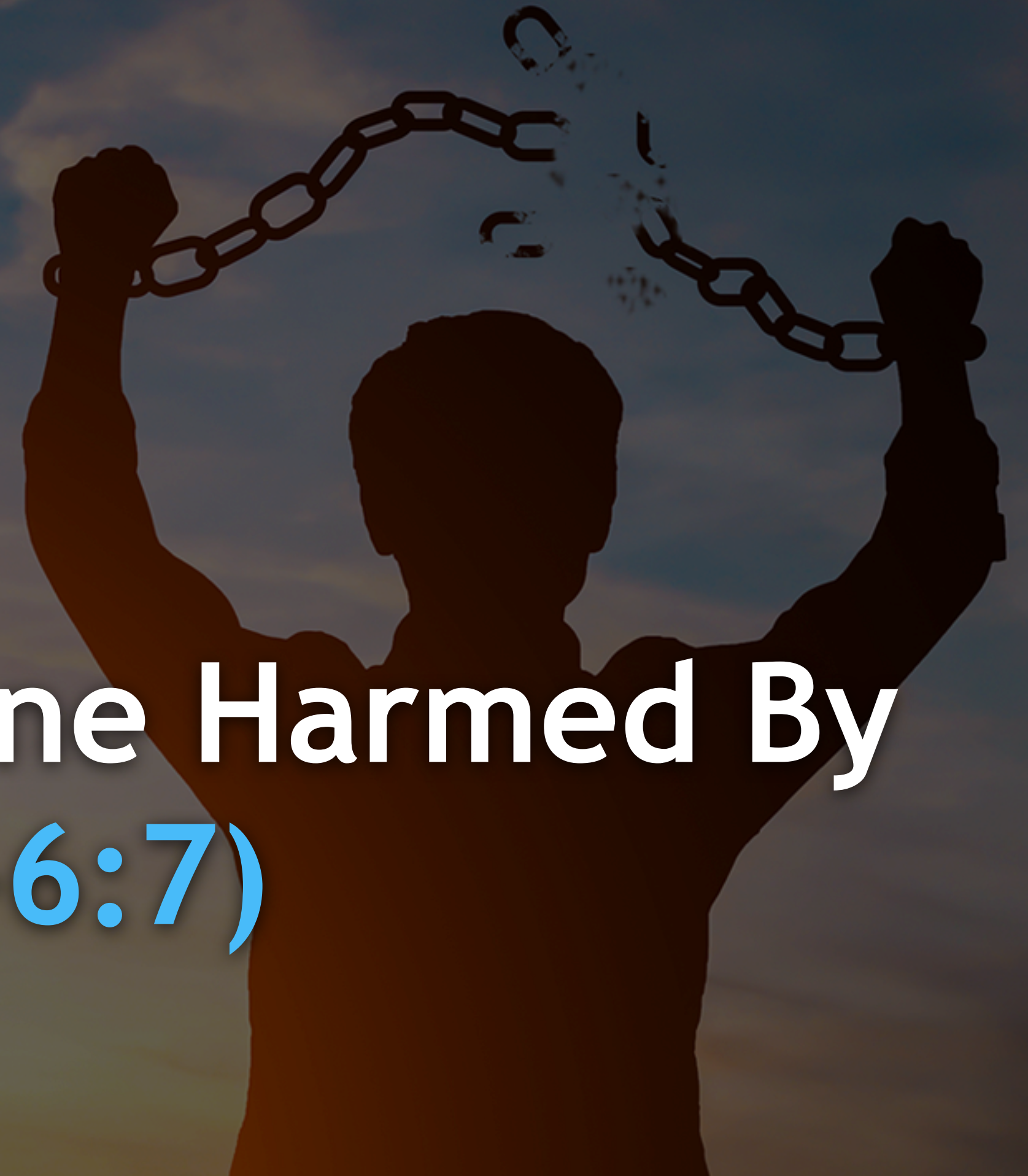
23 Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you,
