The man Jesus described looked at the woman for the purpose of feeding his inner sensual appetites as a substitute for the act. It was not accidental; it was planned. >>



Deuteronomy 24 I "When a man takes a wife and marries her, and it happens that she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some uncleanness in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, puts it in her hand, and sends her out of his house ...



### 3. On Divorce & Remarriage (v31-32)

Matthew 19 7 They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to give a certificate of divorce, and to put her away?" 8 He said to them, "Moses, because of the hardness of your hearts, permitted you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so.



### 3. On Divorce & Remarriage (v31-32)

1 Corinthians 7 IO Now to the married I command, yet not I but the Lord: A wife is not to depart from her husband. Il But even if she does depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to her husband. And a husband is not to divorce his wife.



## 3. On Divorce & Remarriage (v31-32)

66 On one hand, people are taking divorce far too lightly because they fail to realize its seriousness. On the other hand, the church too often mistakenly stands ready to judge and condemn couples who have admittedly failed, but who have sought the Lord and are now starting a new life together. 
And you shall not swear by My name falsely, nor shall you profane the name of your God: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:12






# Matthew 5:21-48 Let Jesus Have The Final Word 5. On How You Respond To Hurts (v38-42)

When a person insults us (slaps you on the right cheek) we want to give them back what they gave to us, plus more.
