- ◆ 1968 Flu - Death Toll: 1 Million
- ◆ 1956 Flu - Death Toll: 2 Million
- ◆ 1918 Flu - Death Toll: 20-50 Million
- ◆ 1910 Cholera - Death Toll: 800 Thousand
- ◆ 1889 Flu - Death Toll: 1 Million
- ◆ 1346 Bubonic Plague - Death Toll: 75-200 Million
