



Therefore, when He had risen from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this to them; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had said.




- I And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ.


In saying this, Jesus wasn't being uncooperative, only asserting His legal right.






Jesus did not resist evil, but endeavored to bring His accusers and judges calmly to face their own consciences.






5. Jesus Invites Everyone To Hear The Truth (v37)



Jesus' words were an invitation for Pilate to listen to Him and to learn the truth. Jesus showed more interest in appealing to Pilate than in defending Himself. This desire for the welfare of others marks all of Jesus' interviews in the fourth Gospel.
