





Leviticus 27 Types Of Dedications To The Lord 1. Person (v1-8) 2. Animal (v9-13) 3. Property (v14-25)






Although the believer today doesn't take a Nazarite vow, there is the offer of a closer walk with the Lord. It is voluntary. You must want it. It is an act of dedication.






5. Devotion To God Is A Gift To God (v13-21)






