

(1 Kings 12:21-24)

1 Corinthians 14

- I Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.
- 2 For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.
