




The Lord commanded His prophet never to marry and rear children. In contrast, God commanded Hosea to marry and have children. This difference reflects God's sovereignty over His servants. His will for one may not be the same as His will for another.







We should suppose that like most others, Jeremiah looked for the blessings and benefits of marriage and parenthood. These were legitimate desires for him to have; yet in order to fulfill the call of God upon his life, he may need to deny such things to pursue the higher call.

The reason for this antisocial behavior, Israel's sovereign God explained, was that He would soon end all rejoicing in the land. Jeremiah was to reflect the attitudes of His God in all these situations. His withdrawal from village life pictured Yahweh's withdrawal and estrangement from His people.

17 'We played wedding songs, and you didn't dance, so we played funeral songs, and you didn't mourn.'

18 For John didn't spend his time eating and drinking, and you say, 'He's possessed by a demon.'

19 The Son of Man, on the other hand, feasts and drinks, and you say, 'He's a glutton and a drunkard, and a friend of tax collectors and other sinners!' But wisdom is shown to be right by its results."

NLT

- 1 Accept other believers who are weak in faith, and don't argue with them about what they think is right or wrong.
 - 2 For instance, one person believes it's all right to eat anything. But another believer with a sensitive conscience will eat only vegetables.
- 3 Those who feel free to eat anything must not look down on those who don't. And those who don't eat certain foods must not condemn those who do, for God has accepted them.
- 4 Who are you to condemn someone else's servants? Their own master will judge whether they stand or fall. And with the Lord's help, they will stand and receive his approval.
- 5 In the same way, some think one day is more holy than another day, while others think every day is alike. You should each be fully convinced that whichever day you choose is acceptable.
