
The disciple who ministers to a person with no status, as though he or she was ministering to Jesus, does in fact minister to Jesus and to God the Father, because that person has status with God.

35 He sat down, called the twelve disciples over to him, and said,"Whoever wants to be first must take last place and be the servant of everyone else."


