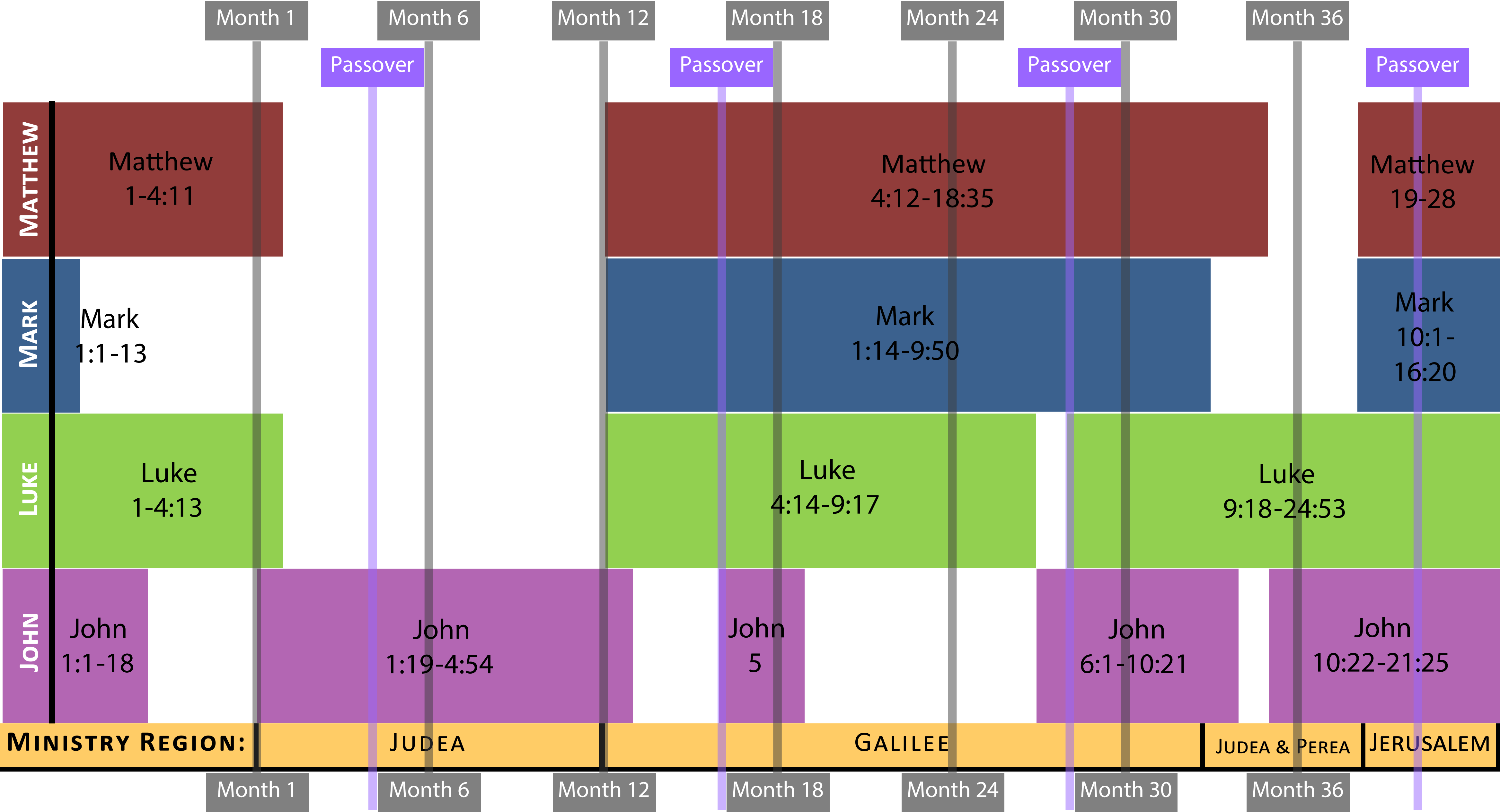
Luke 9
